CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS (Inc. PARENTS)

The club believes that it is important that members, instructors, officers and parents associated with the association should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Chief Instructor/President.

As a member of SKKK you are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- All members must obey the association rules at all times and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background, sexual orientation or religion.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their instructor or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable clothing/footwear for training sessions, as agreed with the instructor/team manager.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Members are not allowed to smoke in or around any SKKK Dojo premises.
- Members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the Dojo premises or whilst representing the club (unless at a properly organised function)
